The Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 requires that each employer "... ((1) An employer shall notify the nearest occupational safety and health office of any accident, dangerous occurrence, occupational poisoning or occupational disease which has occurred or is likely to occur at the place of work. ..." (Act 514, Section 32).
